#### Steps to Upload an Unlisted Video on YouTube

YouTube has three privacy options for videos: **public**, **unlisted**, and **private**.

- **Public videos** can be seen and searched by anyone.
- **Unlisted videos** can only be viewed by people who have the link and won't appear in **YouTube search results**.
- **Private videos** are fully private and can only be accessed by people who are **invited via email**.

#### Step 1: Sign in to Your YouTube Account

- Go to youtube.com and sign in to your account. If you don't have a YouTube account, create one by following the sign-up process.

#### Step 2: Click on the Create Button

- On the top right corner of the YouTube homepage (if you're using a computer), click on the **Create** button then select 'Upload Video.'
- On your mobile device, click the **Plus** button (+) on the bottom of your screen.

#### Step 3: Select the Video You Want to Upload

- Select the video you want to upload from your computer or mobile device. You can also upload from a cloud storage service like Google Drive or Dropbox.

#### Step 4: Add Video Details

- Enter the following information:
  - **Title:** DPYO Audition – first name and last name initial (ex. Melissa M.)
  - **Description:** Title and Composer of the piece(s) you're playing.

#### Step 5: Set the Video to "Unlisted"

- In the **Privacy** section, select the **Unlisted** option. This will prevent your video from being publicly indexed and only available to those who have the link.

**Step 6: Review and Confirm**

- Review the details you've entered, and if everything looks good, click **Upload** to start uploading your video.

**Step 7: Share Link to [education@daytonperformingarts.org](mailto:education@daytonperformingarts.org)**

- Click the three vertical dots next to your video and click either the “share video” button or the “get shareable link” button.
- Paste that link into an email and send to [education@daytonperformingarts.org](mailto:education@daytonperformingarts.org)
